All complaints are investigated and appropriate legal actions, criminal and/or civil, are taken against any member who is not using received items in compliance with Convoy of Hope guidelines. Convoy of Hope cooperates fully with all law enforcement and administrative agencies while investigating complaints. Furthermore, members not using received items in compliance with Convoy of Hope's agency distribution list will be removed from Convoy of Hope's approved list and reinstatement will be contingent upon the outcome of the investigation.

Hope Network Members should realize that violation of Convoy of Hope's policy against <u>sale</u>, <u>barter</u>, <u>or exchange</u> of dated items has far-reaching implications. For instance, donors may discontinue their provisions of food and supplies that other member agencies rely upon to meet the need of children and families.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

• Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
- Form 1099-B (stock or mutual fund sales and certain other transactions by brokers)
- Form 1099-S (proceeds from real estate transactions)
- Form 1099-K (merchant card and third party network transactions)
- Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
- Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
- Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding,
